

RHI requires proper mask etiquette at all times while in this facility. This guideline protects everyone. Masks are to be worn during *every* face to face interaction with staff and patients, even when social distancing, *and if in a patient's room*.



Please sanitize your hands before placing your mask and avoid touching your mask while you are wearing it. Sanitize hands again after removing and discarding your mask.

RHI reserves the right to suspend visitation privileges if our guidelines are not followed.



Visitor Guidelines and Responsibilities

Thank you for assisting RHI in keeping you and our patients safe. This is our top priority! During your visit to our facility, please be mindful of your surroundings and follow recommended practices. If at any time RHI finds we are unable to maintain safe practices and social distancing during visitation, we reserve the right to implement further restrictive measures.

- RHI is allowing **1 visitor** (18 years and older) per patient
 - \circ Visitors will not be allowed to return for the day after they have left the building.
 - Visitors should not be taking patients outside to meet with other family members. Visitation privileges may be removed in these situations.
- Please note our **modified visiting hours** for **Inpatient**:

Monday through Friday - 9am to 4pm Saturday and Sunday - 9am to 4pm

• You will be required to perform Hand Hygiene when entering the hospital and wear a mask that will be provided to you at the screening desk. *Masks must be worn even when outside.*

Visiting in Clinical Areas

- Perform hand hygiene when entering the cafeteria
- Maintain social distancing at all times
- Keep your personal mask on at all times, covering your nose and mouth
- No eating in patient rooms
- No eating in center court or lobby if a therapy group is in session
- Visitors are NOT allowed in the gyms or in therapy groups

Visiting on the Nursing Unit

- Keep your personal mask on at all times, covering your nose and mouth
- Visits in the **patient room**: Maintain social distancing (minimum 6 feet) from other patients and family members by pulling privacy curtains if in a semi-private room
- Do not visit in groups with other patients and family members

Visiting Outside (weather permitting)

- Do not gather in groups with other patients and family members
- Maintain social distancing at all times
- Keep your personal mask on at all times, covering your nose and mouth
