




Case Mix Index (CMI)

RHI's inpatients are admitted with close to the same functional and medical complications as the national average. (higher number indicates more complicated condition).







Expected CMS Functional Outcome Measure

This measure takes a variety of patient factors into consideration such as age, medical factors and mobility and self-care function on admission. CMS uses this information to calculate the expected rate of improvement in mobility and self-care. A patient's progress should meet or exceed the expected value.
