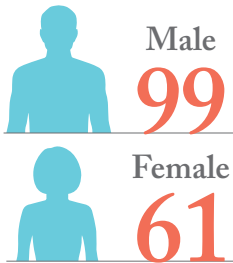

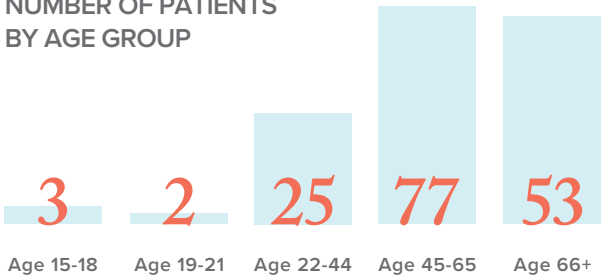
As Indiana’s only CARF-accredited rehabilitation program for spinal cord injury, RHI offers comprehensive individualized care to every patient.

Case Mix Index (CMI)  
RHI’s inpatients are admitted with more severe functional and medical complications (higher number indicates more complicated condition).

2.78 RHI Functional Outcome Measure      2.58 Expected CMS Functional Outcome Measure

This measure takes a variety of patient factors into consideration such as age, medical factors and mobility and self-care function on admission. CMS uses this information to calculate the expected rate of improvement in mobility and self-care. A patient's progress should meet or exceed the expected value.
